| Group Dynamic Expectation | <p>Every day, you should be actively looking for opportunities to do all of the following</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • organize and lead the discussion • summarize, restate, or clarify the progress made to a particular exercise • offer examples from previous worksheets, the textbook, or other sources • ask questions • analyze a proposed solution • constructively comment on or give an opinion of a proposed solution • suggest a solution • defend someone else's solution • appropriately make a correction to someone else's work • ask for clarification or more information • enrich the discussion of a correct solution by showing a different method • refocus a discussion that is off-task • fill in a missing step of a proposed solution • check that others in the group understand a solution |

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| | <p>Every day, you should be actively trying to make all of the following happen:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • allow everyone to participate more or less equally • set a pace that allows for clarity and thoughtfulness • establish a sense of balance and order by focusing in on one speaker and one idea at a time • attempt to resolve questions and issues before moving on to new ones • make sure there is a clear sense of what the group has covered and how • establish a culture in which the loud do not dominate, the shy are encouraged, and everyone is clearly understood • check to make sure everyone in the group understands the information covered and the conclusions reached at the end of each exercise • adjust if the discussion about a particular exercise is not "working"; in particular, if you are not happy with the way a discussion about a particular exercise is going, say so • take risks by digging for new connections and alternate methods of solution • make sure every statement, solution, and conclusion is backed up by examples, definitions, theorems, etc. |
